



Projects Funded To Date






Results

- Since 2017, 18 million for 42 community projects:
 - Ø \$6.6 million for asthma-related health programs
 - Ø \$4.5 million for parks and open space projects
 - Ø \$3 million in stormwater projects
 - Ø \$1.6 million for solar water heating and solar generation projects
 - Ø \$1.2 million for air filtration/HVAC projects
 - Ø \$1.1 for energy efficiency projects
- Adds to 125 projects previously funded 2009-2017



